About 24 students from ALOHA Jalahalli Centre enthusiastically participated in the competition. They were perfectly trained and

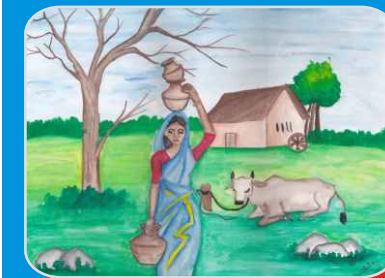
guided by Mr. Sanjay Sureka, ALOHA Unit Franchisee and Course Instructor Ms. Shilpa Rajashekar.

The competition was for 5 minutes and within that time limit the child has to solve 100 sums. For higher levels the number of sums was increased with extra time.

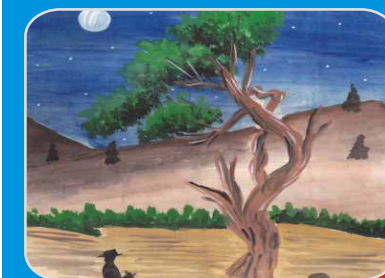
Above 5th level the time limit was 8 minutes with 180 sums to be solved.

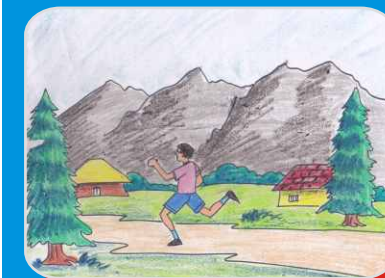

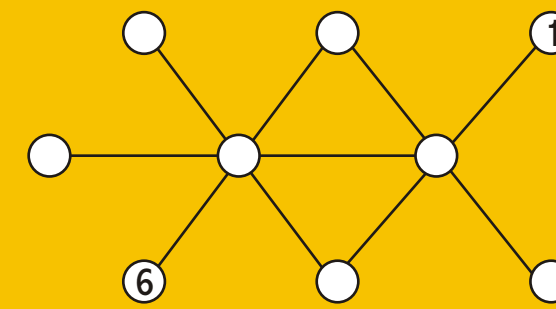

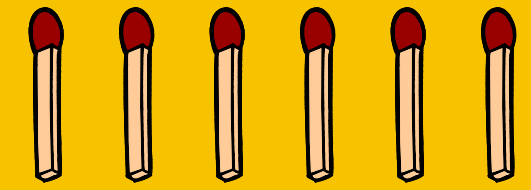

Tickle your Brain

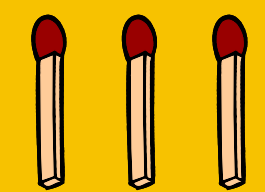


1. Can you arrange the numbers 1 to 9 in the circle so that each straight line of three number totals 18?
