- 2 The competition time allotted for each group is 5 minutes.
- 3 MA & TT-Level 1, question paper comprises of 80 Questions to be completed in 5 minutes.  
MA Level 2-8, TT Level 2-10, SM & ES question paper comprises of 70 Questions to be completed in 5 minutes.
  - English Smart students should underline or circle or tick the correct answer from the given options.
  - Speed Maths students can do the rough work in the space given in the question paper itself.
- 4 Registration fee of ₹1000/- for MA, TT, SM, ES and HS should be paid to the respective Aloha Learning Centre at the time of submission of the application form.
- 5 Application form should be sent through the respective Aloha Learning Centre only.
- 6 Incomplete or incorrect application forms will be rejected without any intimation.
- 7 Please fill the student's name correctly & legibly (in capital) as it appears in the company records.
- 8 Please note that the certificates will be issued as per the particulars filled in the application form.
- 9 Last date for registration-20/11/2017, REGISTRATION WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DESIGNATED DATE.
- 10 Registration fee is non-refundable and non-transferable once the application form is accepted for registration.
- 11 Speed Maths, English Smart competition will be conducted on completed level wise only (There are no groups).
- 12 The student must wear ALOHA T-shirt which will be provided along with ADMIT CARD.
- 13 Any appeal / complaints regarding registration / ADMIT CARD should be lodged before 20/11/2017. 
## ELIGIBILITY
